Citizens for Local Choice Submits Initiative Petition to the Bureau of Elections

LANSING, Mich. - The Ballot Campaign Committee, "Citizens for Local Choice," today submitted an initiative petition to the Bureau of Elections to amend the Clean and Renewable Energy and Energy Waste Reduction Act to, among other things, repeal Part 8 as added by Public Act 233 of 2023. The Committee has requested approval of the Summary of Purpose and pre-approval as to form.

The Summary of Purpose provided to the Bureau for consideration provides:

"A proposed initiated law to allow local units of government to retain authority to regulate the development of solar, wind, or energy storage facilities in their jurisdictions by repealing laws that mandate statewide standards for energy facilities and permit the Michigan Public Service Commission to override local energy facility development decisions. If enacted, this proposal will allow local units of government to continue to determine their own standards regarding setback distance, structure height, and the amount of light and sound emitted by energy facilities, and to exercise final authority over the construction of energy facilities within their jurisdictions."

The summary will be prepared by the Director of Elections for consideration by the Board of Canvassers. The Board of Canvassers is expected to approve the petition within 30 days, following which the Committee will be granted a 180-day window to gather and file the necessary 356,958 valid signatures from registered voters. To ensure placement on the November 2024 ballot, valid signatures must be submitted by May 29th; otherwise, the initiative will proceed to the November 2026 ballot. I recently read an article by the former Speaker of the House Newt Gingrich commenting on a report published by the Rassmussen Polling Firm. The firm interviewd a large number of Americans and discovered "the driving force behind the destructive radicalism which is pushing us into a cultural civil war." Surprise everyone! It is not the so called Alt-right. What Rassmussen found is both shocking and disturbing, and unfortunately we ignore it at our own peril.

OUT of every 1000 respondents the firm uncovered three to four who were far more radical than anyone else. Who are these people? After doing deeper comparison research the results showed some deep commonalities among these people. They had graduate degrees, family incomes in excess of \$150k a year, and lived in large cities. Despite the prevailing job approval that our current pretender in chief receives, these people gave him a whopping 81% approval rating! Not unsurprising they are overwhelmingly Democrat (73%), young (between 35 and 54 years old) and nearly half (47%) favor a Bernie Sanders styled socialism. What is shocking is that the vast majority of them, 86% are white.

When broken down into those who consider themselves politically obsessed, nearly 70% of them say there is too much individual freedom in America, and say they 'trust government to do the right thing most of the time."

PERHAPS most disturbing of all though is that "35% of the elite 1%, and 69% of the politically obsessed said THEY WOULD RATHER CHEAT THAN LOSE A CLOSE ELECTION!" This group also overwhelmingly finds that both Congress and journalists fall into their favorable categories and are in favor of the current collection of college professors. They support stricter restrictions on private use of gas, eating meat, and the banning of most of what middle Americans rely on every day for transportation and heating.

SO who are these people? "According to Rassmussen, the most radical of the elite 1 percent were educated at what he calls the 'dirty dozen,' Harvard, Yale, U of Penn, Northwestern, John Hopkins, Columbia, Stanford, Berkeley, Princton, Cornell, MIT, and the University of Chicago." These are the people who dominate the universities, media, judiciary, three letter agencies, massive foundations and most major corporations. They intermarry and live in the same zip codes. And they firmly believe that their views are the 'common sense, mainstream values.'

WHY, you ask, should we care? These are the same people who in 1972 were convinced that McGovern was going to decimate Nixon. And these are the same people who woke up on that Wednesday morning flabergasted that this crazy, Alt-Right demagogue had swept the country.

WE have to be careful that we are not living in the same kind of echo chamber. We also have to have at our disposal this information so we can talk to Independents and the Moderate Democrats in our lives. I truly believe that most Americans do not reflect these radical values, but those conversations have to start taking place so that we, the people, left, right, and center, stand a chance to leverage the country back from the radical Marxist, big government primrose path those at the highest level are leading us down.
